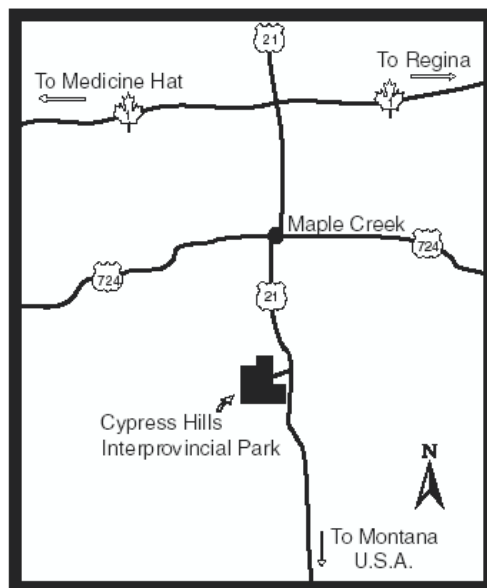

SSSP 2010 Fr. Kemble Memorial Lecture

Stan Shadick: Department of Physics and Eng. Physics, U. of Sask.

“Investigating Exoplanets with Small Telescopes”

In 1988, three astronomers from western Canada published the first confirmed discovery of a planet in orbit around a star other than the Sun. Since then, more than 450 exoplanets have been discovered in over 380 planetary systems. This talk will review what we have learned about the properties of these planets. It will then focus on how amateur astronomers can use cameras attached to their own telescopes to measure the size of these planets and how amateurs may contribute to the search for additional exoplanets or even exomoons.
