Learning Objectives:

- learning vocabulary for 4β
- masculine nouns of the 1<sup>st</sup> declension
  - ὁ δεσπότης
  - ὁ νεανίας
- feminine nouns of the 2<sup>nd</sup> declension: ἡ ὁδός, ἡ νῆσος
- overview of 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>-declension adjectives:
  - καλός, -ή, -όν
  - ῥάδιος, -ᾶ, -ον
- mixed-stem adjectives:
  - μέγας, μεγάλη, μέγα
  - πολύς, πολλή, πολύ
- formation of adverbs in -ως
- overview of the definite article: ὁ, ἡ, τό

Notes

- pay serious attention to the text's advice (section 8) about using the definite article to determine the case and gender of unfamiliar (or forgotten!) nouns.
- types of noun learned to date:
